Problem Solving	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Prioritizes IT project requests and determines best practices to be employed in the implementation and completion of all projects. This includes pre-design, design, project implementation and project completion phases. * Provide project planning and management for a limited number of major projects while consulting with division leads on project management on their assigned projects. * Work with CSU Online Finance and CSU Purchasing to develop a bid strategy consistent with University policies and procedures * Review and analyze project plans, coordinating with requesting parties and resource managers as required * Identify project goals and key stakeholders * Develop and review project budget and timelines * Identify obstacles, risks, schedule changes, capacity restrictions, personnel changes and other challenges that threaten project success and proactively plans mitigation. * Identify required resources (e.g. personnel, equipment and materials) with long lead times * Conduct project wrap-up activities to finalize budgets, release resources, conduct a post-project assessment with recommendations for process improvements, etc. * Prepare reports on projects status, timelines, and outcomes, including decisions affecting various aspects of the project such as budget, schedule, legal, and quality * Work closely with vendors as appropriate (DestinyOne, Atlassian, Salesforce, etc.). 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ May provide recommendation on analysis, project identification, design, communication, and integration for program ▪ Identifies and escalates potential project/program hurdles and pitfalls
